Ordering your credit reports

As of September 1, 2005 a federal law went into effect that allows individuals to get free copies of their credit reports once a year, from each of the three major credit reporting agencies

The official web site for requesting free reports is www.annualcreditreport.com

You can also call (877) 322-8228

The official site can also be reached through the Federal Trade Commission's web site at www.ftc.gov/freereports, which has a link to the correct web site.

The free credit report does not contain your credit score. Your credit score can be ordered through the site for an additional fee ranging from \$4. to \$8. Your credit score is an actual numerical measure of your creditworthiness used by lenders and others

Examine your reports

Upon receipt of your reports review all information for correctness. This includes Name, Address, Social Security Number, and information concerning creditors indebted to now or in the past. If any items are incorrect, simply complete the enclosed dispute form,

Beware of "Credit Repair" scams, which can come at high cost, yet produce inconsistent results.

Have you been denied credit?

If you have been denied credit, employment, or insurance you are entitled to receive a free credit report.
